NEW FILM PROMOTES SURVEYING TO STUDENTS

The Society of Chartered Surveyors has produced a film about surveying as a way of promoting interest in the profession among second and third level students. The six minute film features representatives of all the different divisions within surveying talking about their daily work, the challenges they face and the satisfaction they derive from their work.

The President of the SCS, Peter Stapleton said the film aimed to get across the wide range of career options which are available to students who pursue a course in property or construction studies.

‘For sure the property and construction sector is going through a very challenging period right now. However the fortunes of the industry are cyclical in nature and the situation will improve in the next three or four years. Then the industry will need well trained property and construction professionals’ Stapleton said.

Stapleton said the SCS wanted to get their message across to prospective students in an easily accessible format.

‘We know that for a lot of people out there surveying is a bit of a mystery, so we see this film as a way of explaining what we do. One thing a lot of surveyors tell us – and this comes across in the film - is that no one day is the same. If you want an exciting career with lots of variety, interesting challenges and a qualification which is recognized all over the world, this could be the profession for you’ he concluded.
